4 Dead, 24 Injured After Truck Hits Stationary Bus

Lucknow : In the early hours of Saturday, a speeding vehicle crashed into a parked bus in Uttar Pradesh's Barabanki district, killing four Nepalese passengers and injuring 24 others. According to authorities, the sleeper bus carrying 60 Nepalese migrant labourers was on its way to Goa when one of its tyres became punctured in Mahangapur village, which falls under the jurisdiction of Ramnagar police station. The bus driver had parked the vehicle on the side of the road and was in the process of replacing a tyre when a fast truck collided with it from behind. Purnendu Singh, additional superintendent of police in Barabanki, claimed that of the 60 passengers, four died on the spot and were named as Prem Tharu, Sheetal Tharu, and Chakra Bahadur, with the identity of one unknown. The injured were sent to the Barabanki district hospital for treatment, and six of them were transferred to Lucknow's KGMU Trauma Center. "The remaining passengers are safe, and we are preparing to return them to Nepal," Singh added. The corpses of those who died have been sent for post-mortem examination, and additional investigation is underway, he added.
